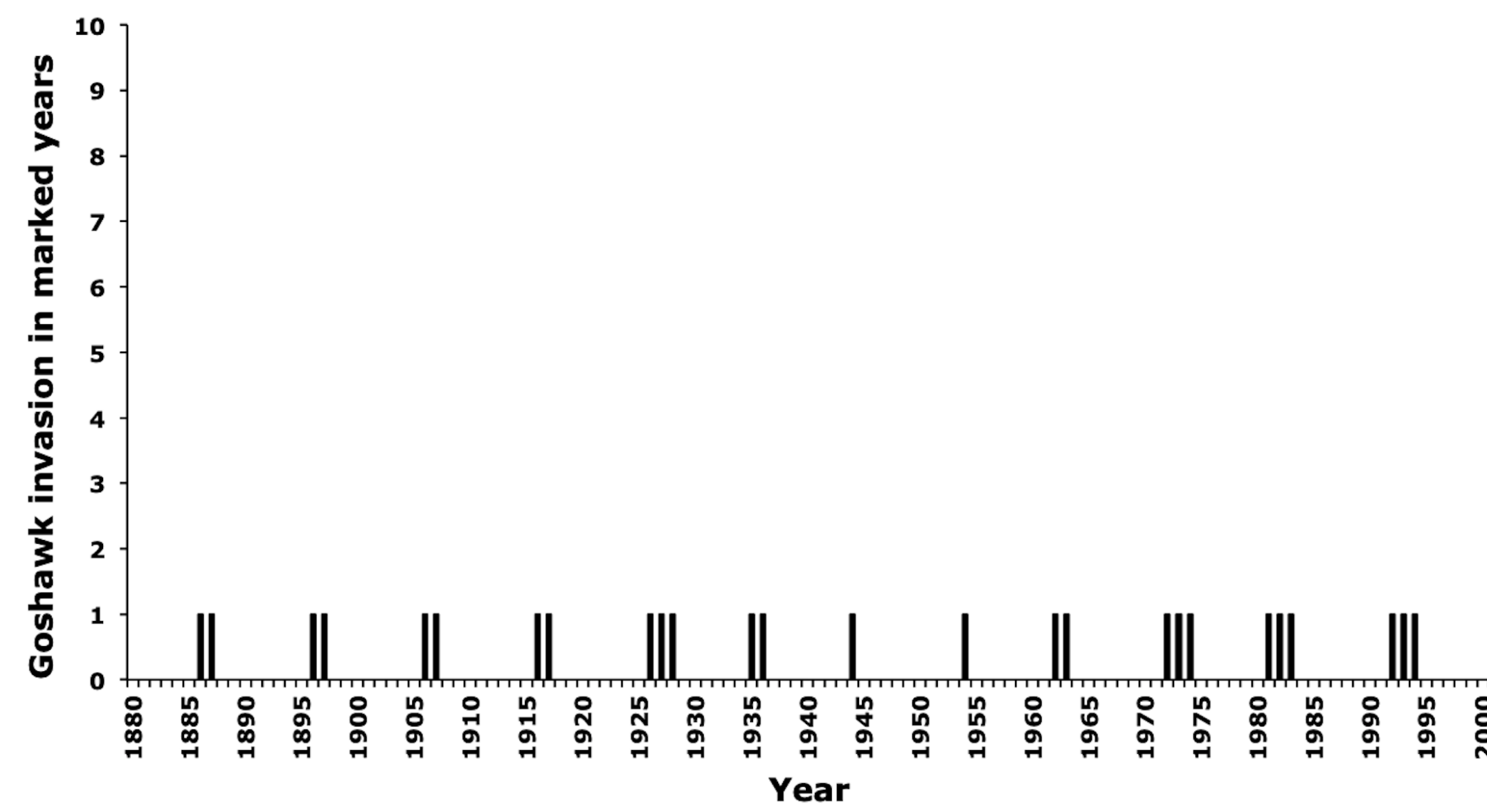

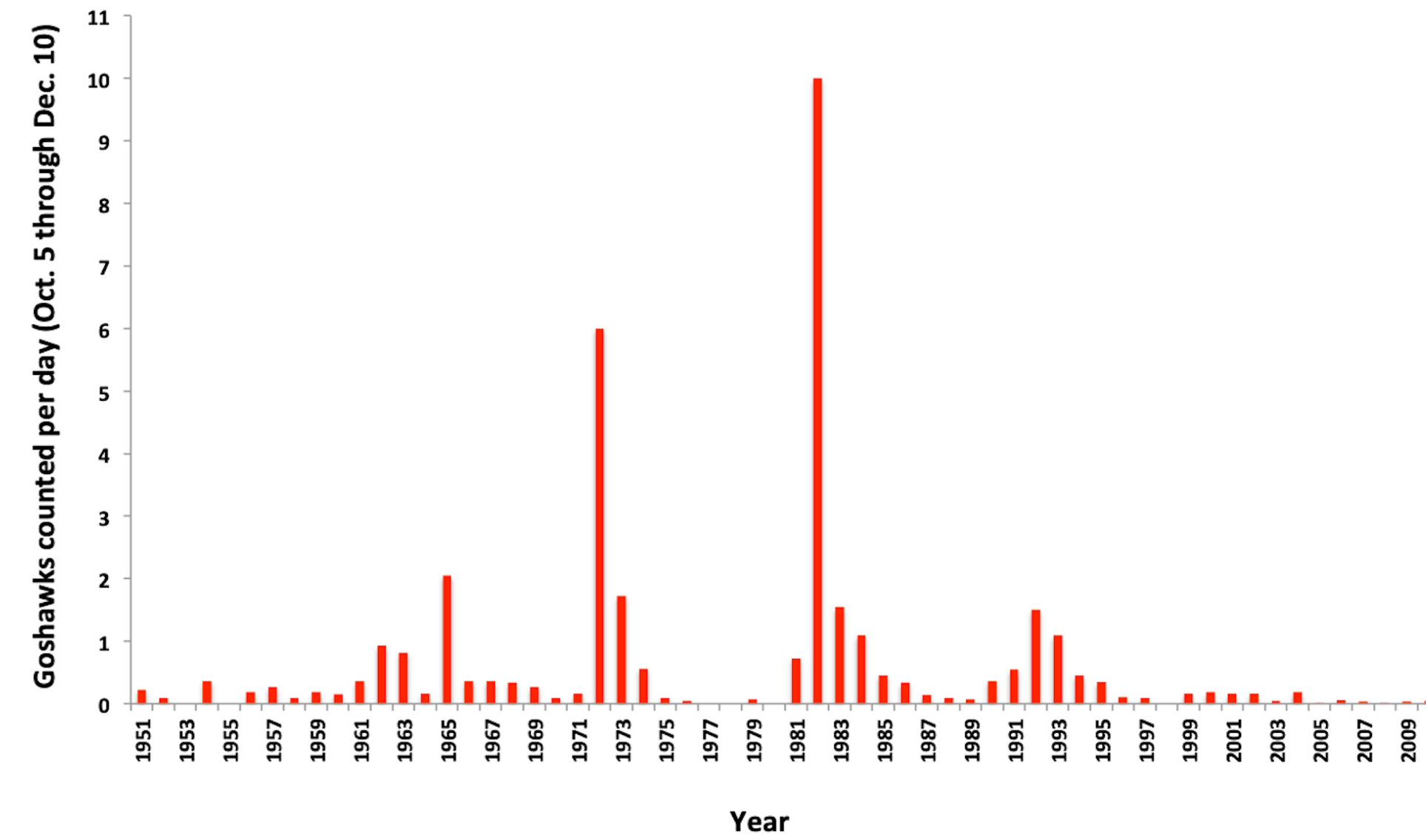

## Counts at Hawk Mountain, Cedar Grove, and Hawk Ridge

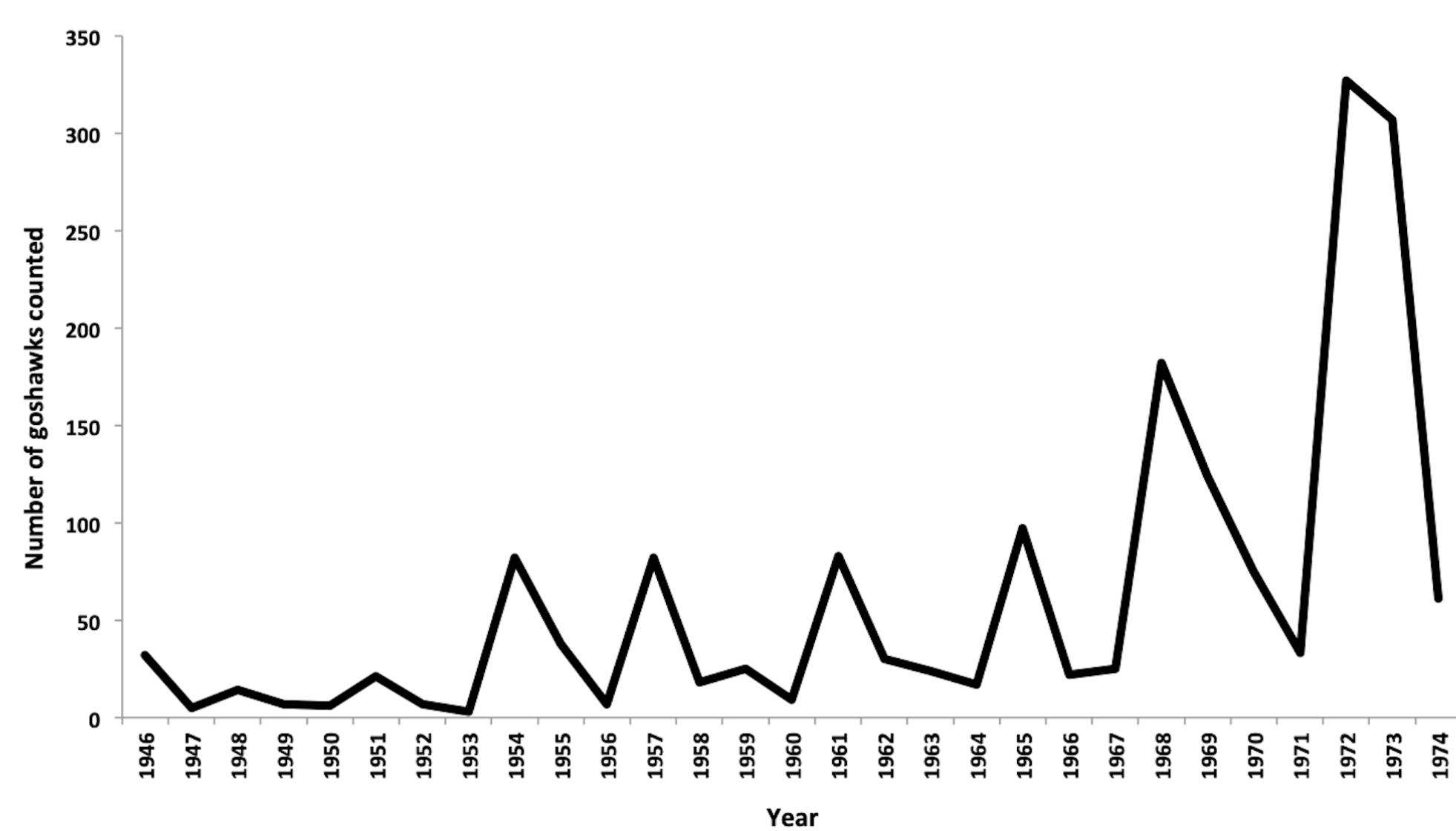
YEARS IN WHICH GOSHAWK INVASIONS OCCURRED (from Newton 2002)



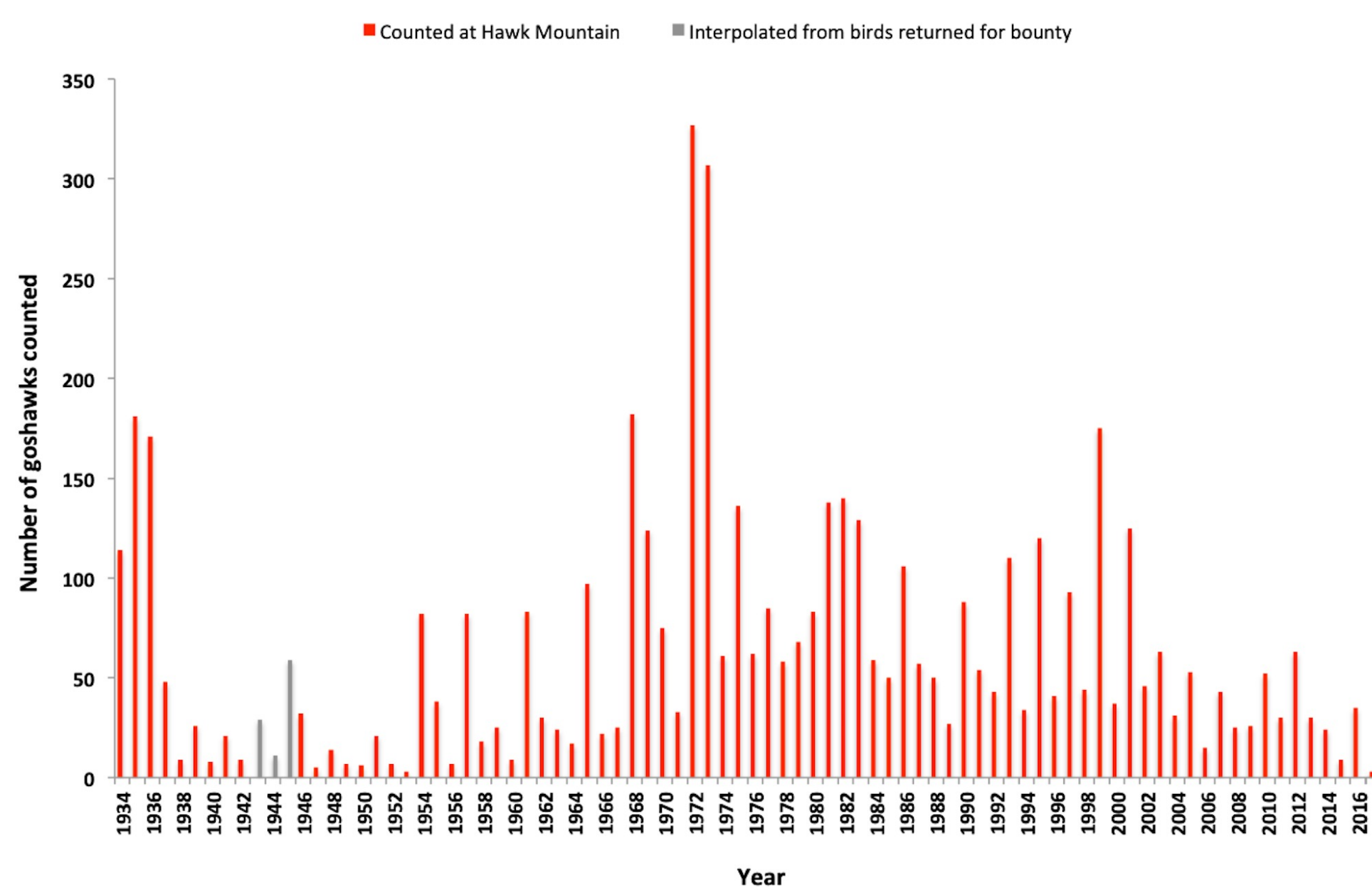
GOSHAWKS COUNTED AT CEDAR GROVE FROM 1951 TO 2004 (Mueller et al. 2008)



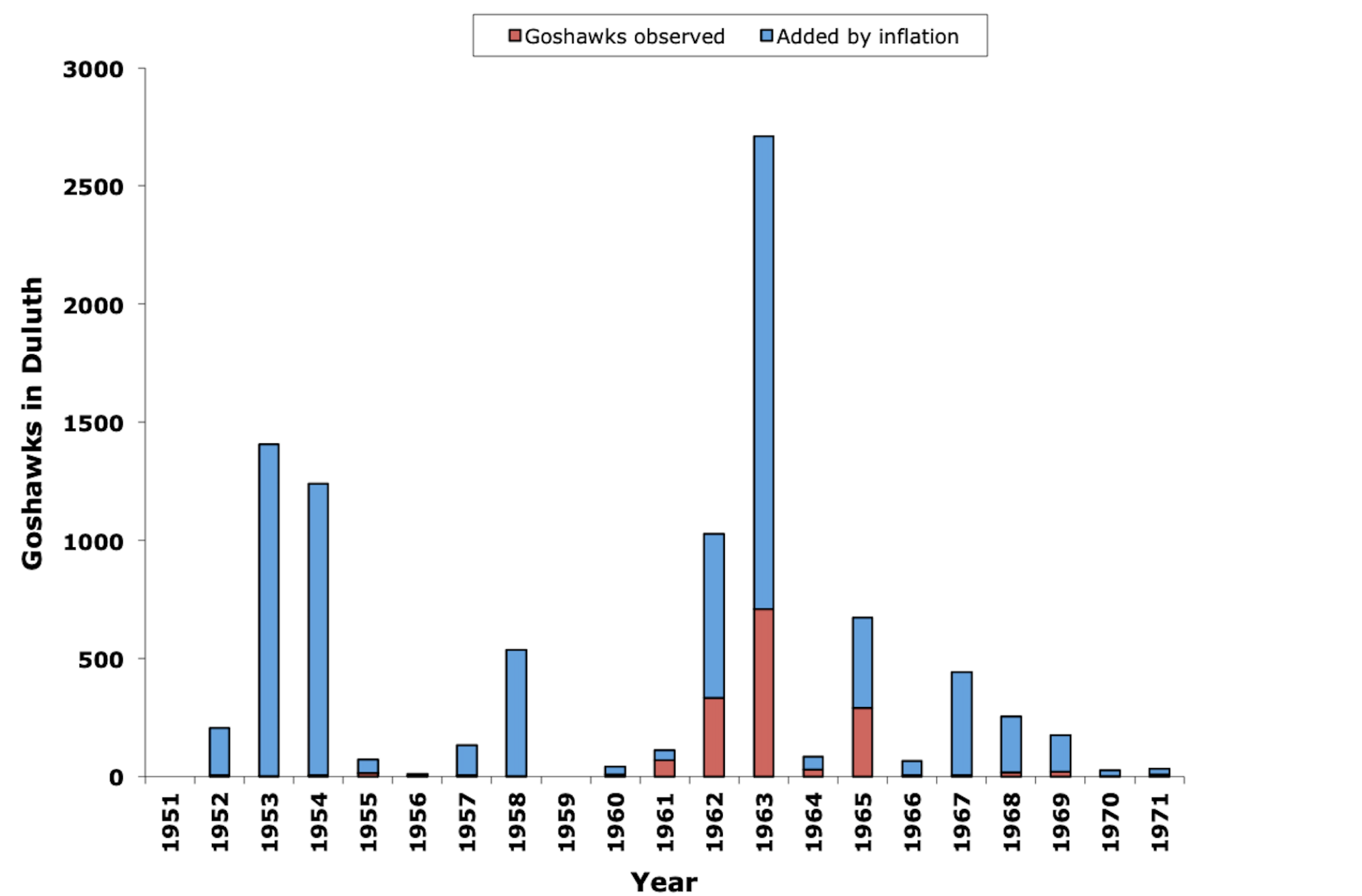
GOSHAWKS COUNTED AT HAWK MOUNTAIN



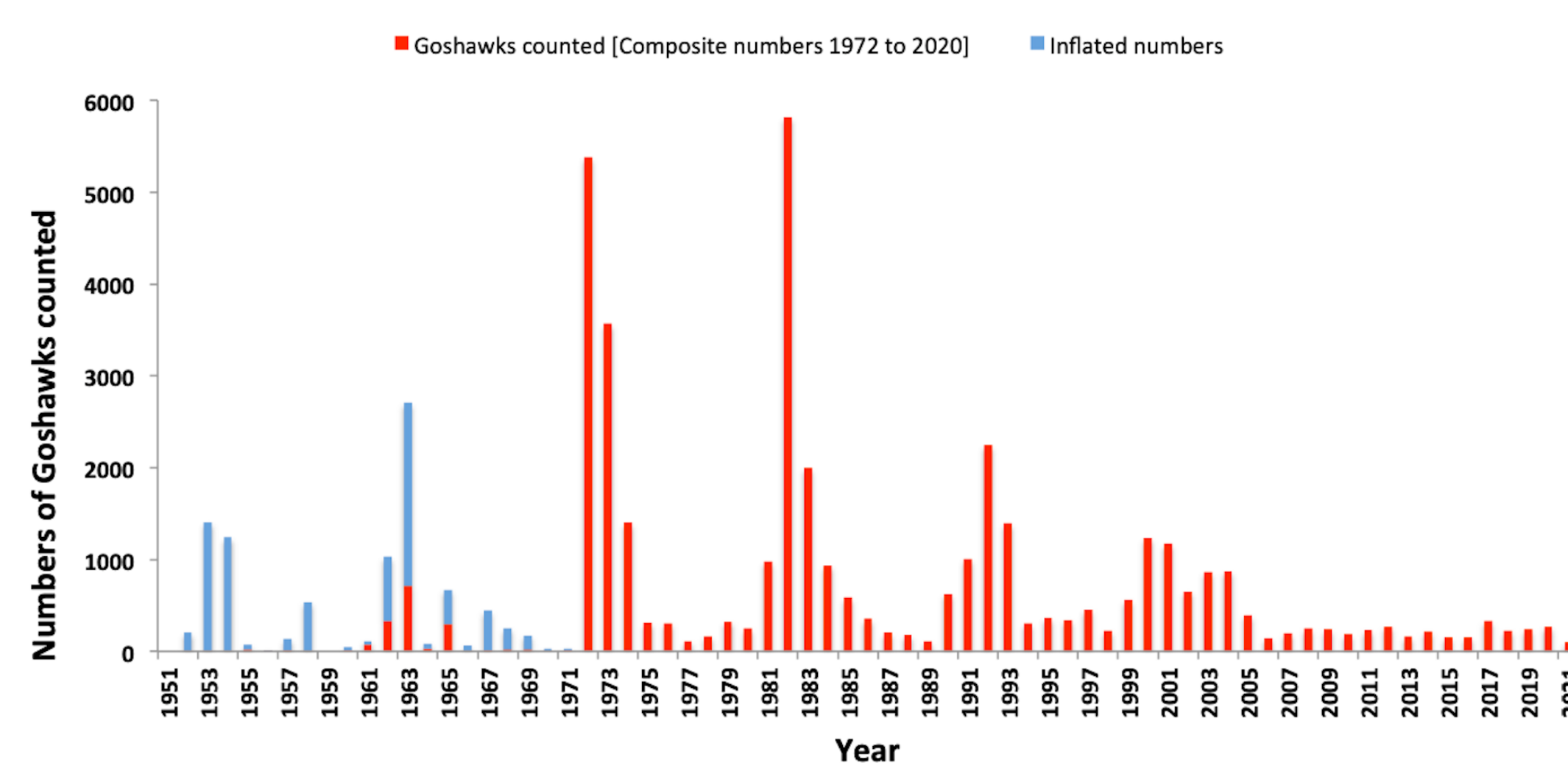

Original and inflated values

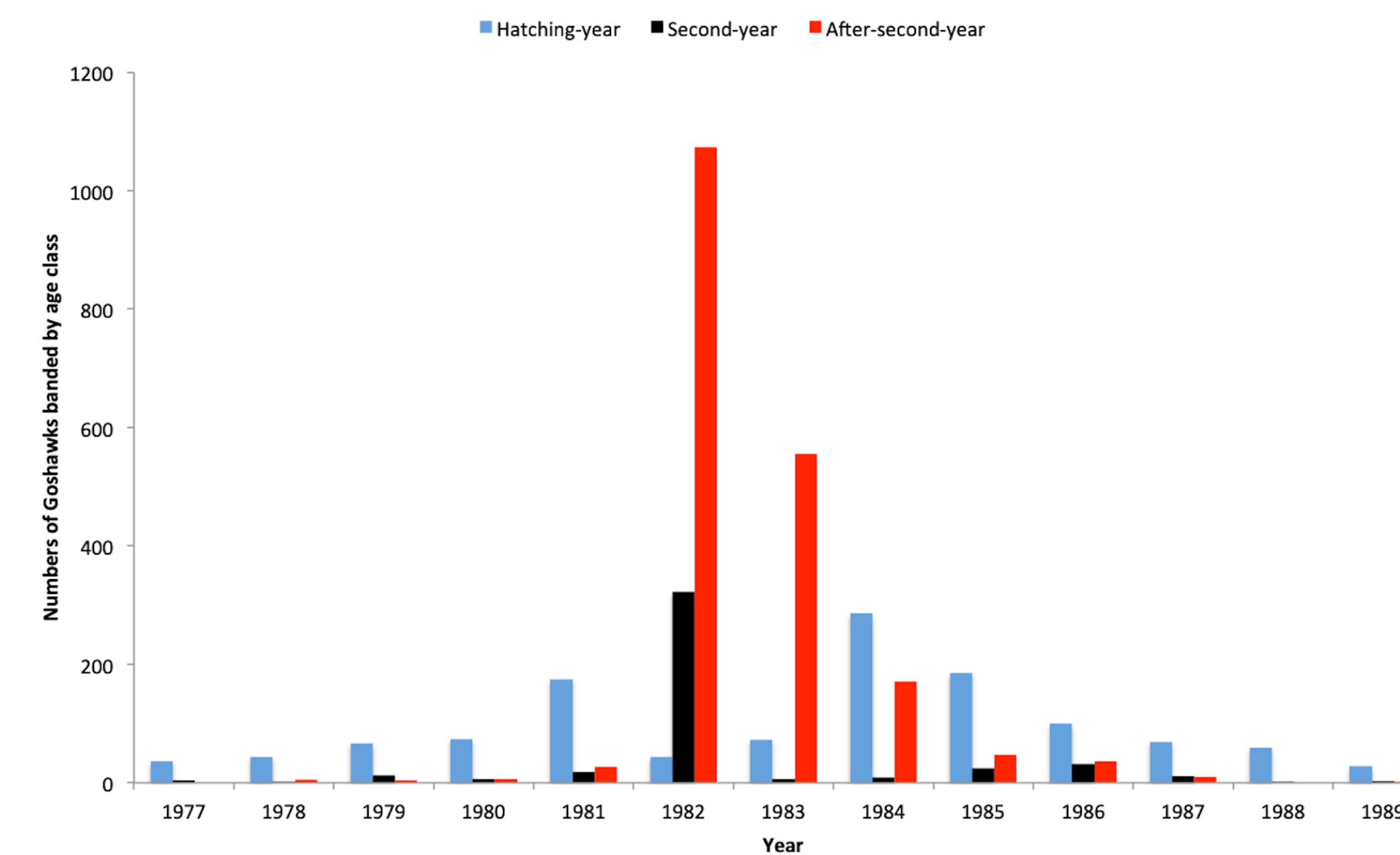


GOSHAWKS SEEN AT HAWK RIDGE FROM 1951 TO 2021

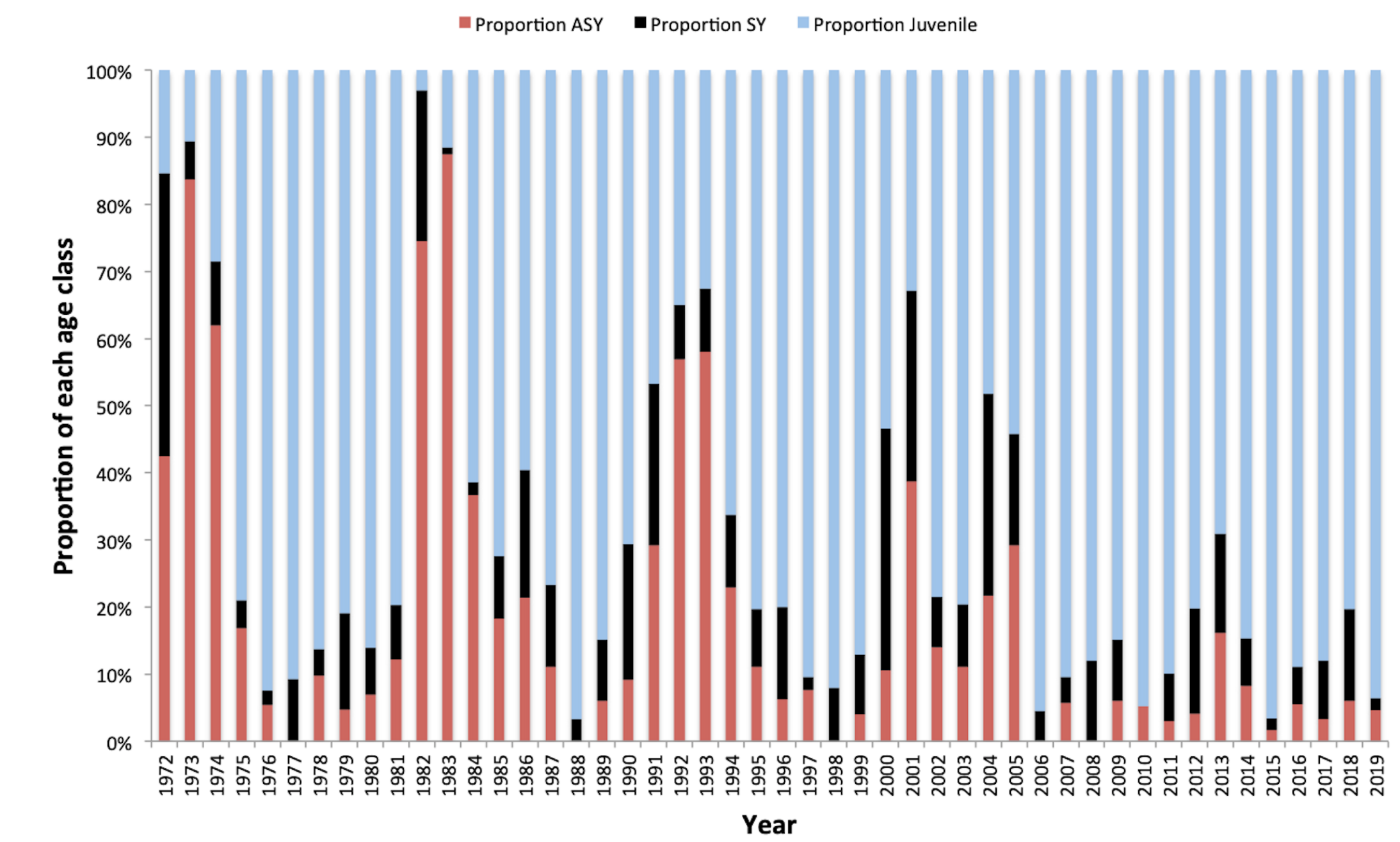

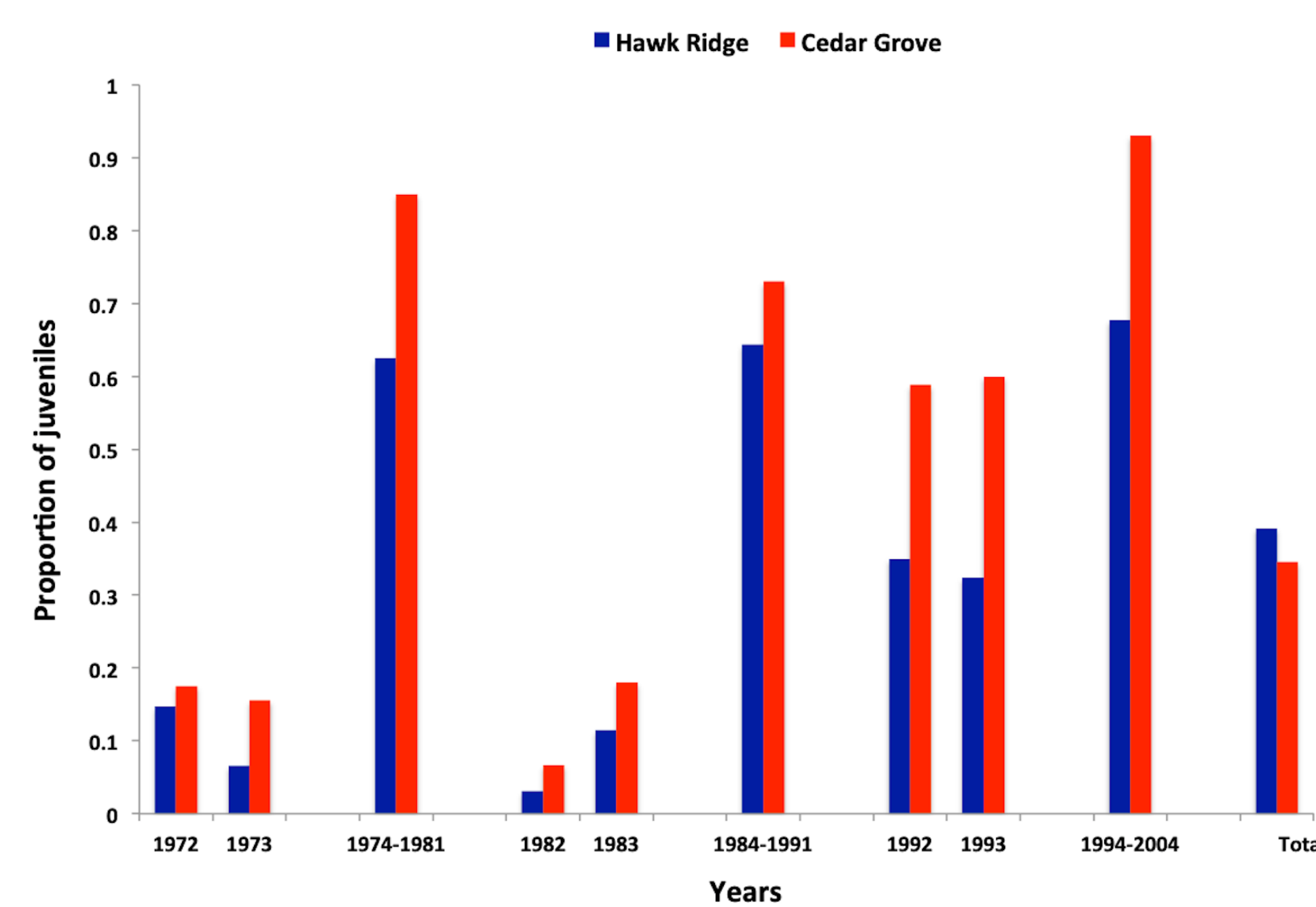
AGE DISTRIBUTION AROUND 1980s INVASION



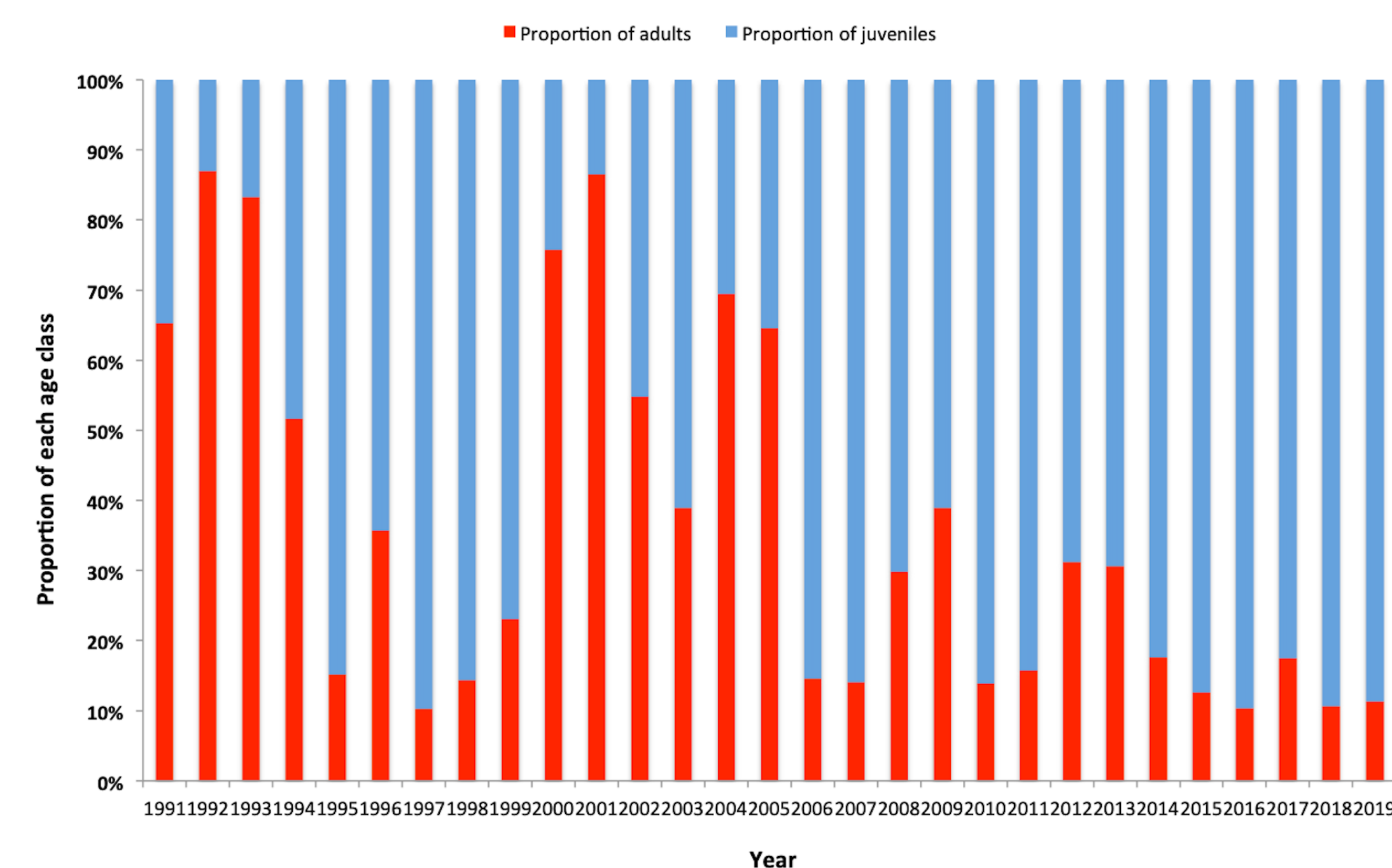
AGE DISTRIBUTION OF GOSHAWKS Banded AT HAWK RIDGE

AGE PROPORTIONS OF GOSHAWKS OBSERVED AT HAWK RIDGE



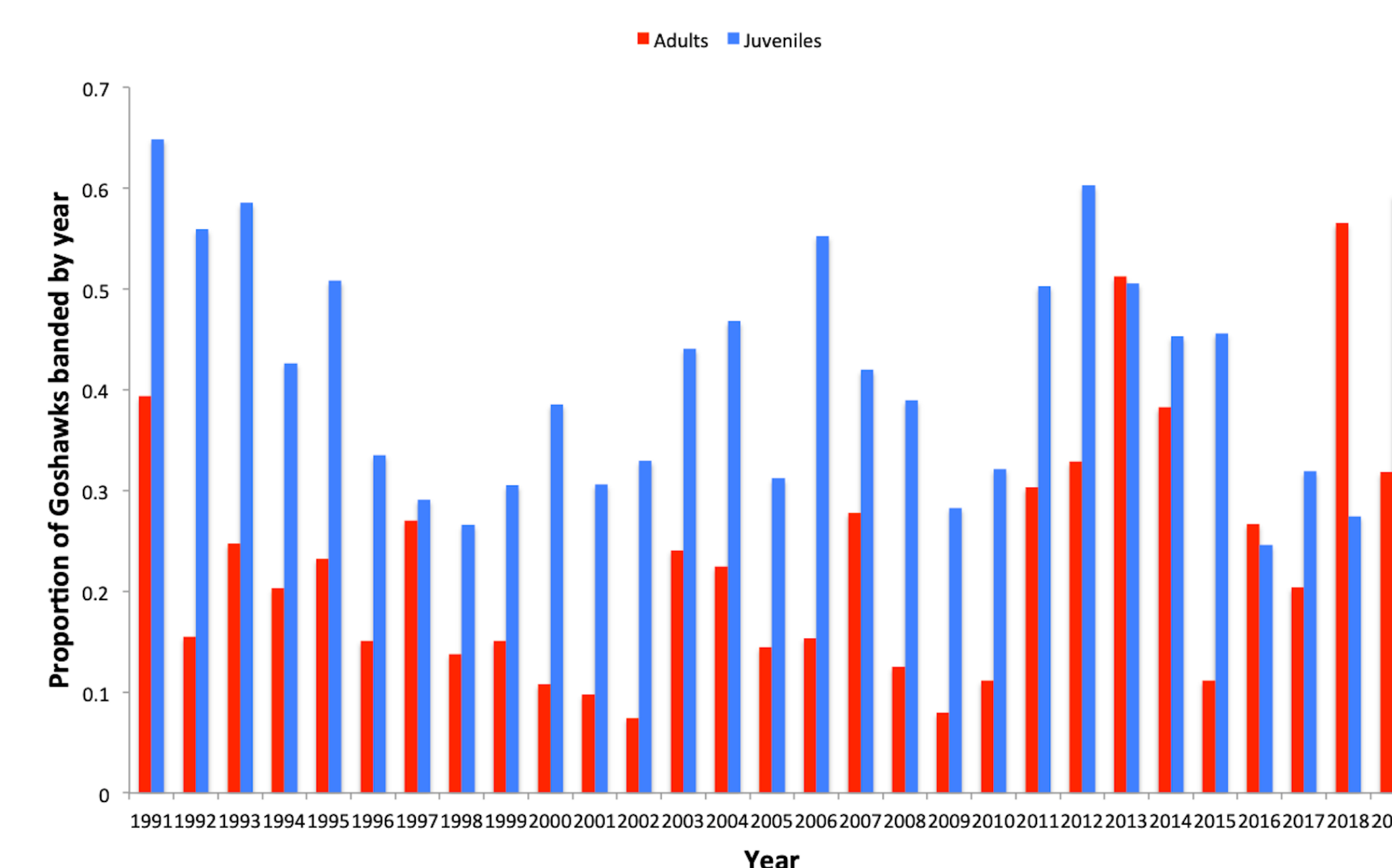
